## USAAF MONUMENT

Motorists, cyclists and walkers cannot fail to be impressed by the reconstructed United States Army Air Force monument in Park Lane, Langham, where the road crosses what was the main runway of Airfield 150. On 19 April a considerable number of people gathered together for the unveiling (by Col J Hosken, US Air Attaché) and rededication (by the Rector) of the monument. The British and American National Anthems were sung and an Honor Guard was provided by the USAF, Mildenhall. Memorable speeches were made by Col Hosken, on behalf of the USAF, and by Mrs Laura Smerdon, on behalf of the people of Langham. Unfortunately, the planned fly-past by a WW2 P51 Mustang fighter did not take place because of conditions at its home runway.

After the ceremony, large numbers visited a fascinating exhibition in the Langham Community Centre showing life and events at the airfield during its operational existence as well as contemporary village scenes and personalities. Copious refreshments were provided by Lanham WI.
