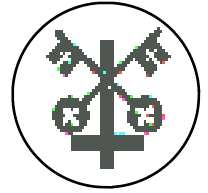

### YOUTH WORKER FOR BOXTED & LANGHAM

The working group managing the exciting Youth Worker project has been given the particulars of a likely candidate for our first Youth Worker appointment. The immediate task, therefore, is to make sure as possible that the young person suits us and that we suit the young person. Contact has been established and an early decision is now expected.

The appointment will be for ten months from September with the purpose of developing Christian youth work for youngsters aged from 9 to 14 in the villages and the two schools as well as the churches. The Youth Worker will liaise with the two primary schools as well as with the two churches. He or she will help to run clubs in the villages, working with the Sunday School children and the Church youth group, SPASM, and being involved as much as possible in church and village life in both Boxted and Langham.

### LENTEN FRUGAL LUNCHES

The annual Lenten Frugal Lunches will begin on Tuesday 3 March. There will be six weekly lunches, the last being on the Tuesday (7 April) of Holy Week. The lunches will follow the Coffee Café, which is from 10.30 am to 12 mid-day.

The soup and rolls are generously provided by the organisers and their helpers. However, donations are invited, the proceeds of which will be passed to the Colchester Emergency Night Shelter. The Shelter provides nourishment and temporary accommodation to the homeless and others in distress.

### BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

Richard Turner of the Boxted Airfield Historical Group gave a thoroughly researched and illustrated talk on the Boxted (Langham) Airfield from its opening in the War to its closure in the sixties. He described the different US and, after the war's end, British aircraft based there but dwelt on the various characters who served at the station. He spoke particularly of the effect the well paid and well provisioned Americans had on the surrounding area and their generosity to the severely rationed villagers, especially the children. His talk stirred the personal memories of not a few listeners.

New arrangements for the policing of Boxted and Langham have been made by the Essex Police. The two villages are the responsibility of the "North Neighbourhood Policing Team" working from Copford Police Station under Sergeant Mike Lee.

Instead of "Community Police Officers", there are now "Neighbourhood Specialist Officers", of whom the one allocated to oversee Boxted and Langham (among several villages, including Dedham) is PC Vicky Sanders. She is assisted by Police Community Support Officer (PCSO) Sue Donaldson, who is also concerned with a number of other villages.
