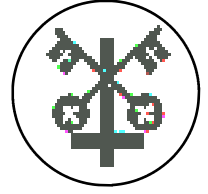

LANGHAM PARISH PLAN

The Parish Plan Association (PPA) formed in April on the initiative of the Parish Council is charged with devising a framework for the social future of the village – the Parish Plan. Since April working groups have been constructing a questionnaire for completion by everyone in Langham as the basis for creating a Parish Plan that, as far as practicable, reflects people's wishes.

A "mini" questionnaire, concentrating on Community Centre facilities, has already been sent out and over 500 replies have so far been received and analysed. It was necessary to send out this specific questionnaire in advance because of early deadlines for applications for the grant-funding of Community Centre developments. The replies showed overwhelming support for expansion of the Centre but there has been a delay in agreeing the final design specification and planning consent is still required. This delay has put the project back until next year's round of grant applications.

Work proceeds on developing the main questionnaire. However, the PPA does not want to burden people with another questionnaire so soon after the "mini" one. Moreover, experience has shown that surveys attract a fuller response in the warmer months and longer daylight. For these reasons the PPA will now be issuing the main questionnaire, not this autumn, as originally planned, but in April-June 2010.
