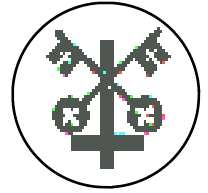

### LANGHAM WOMEN'S INSTITUTE

Paul Howe gave the March meeting a most interesting account of the origins, history and current activities of Trinity House. Trinity House, founded by Royal Charter granted by Henry VIII, is almost unique in doing the same job for 500 years. Its tasks include supervising the safe navigation of the now very crowded shipping lanes around our shores, surveying and marking wrecks, seabed surveys and maintaining lightships, lighthouses and buoys. These are all functions that increasingly make use of modern technology and automation. Trinity House's ships "Patricia" and "Galatea" are familiar to visitors to Harwich—it is possible for people to join them to enjoy a cruise and watch their work at sea.

This was an "open" meeting and the many members present were joined by a good number of friends, husbands and others from around Langham.

## LITTLE OWLS PRESCHOOL, BOXTED

Little Owls PreSchool has received a capital works grant of £340,251 from the Essex Early Years Development and Childcare Partnership to finance a replacement building on the King George Playing Field. Planning permission has been given and it is hoped to have the purpose-designed new building in use in early September.

At the start of the year Maggie Bland stepped down as manager after nearly thirty years of close association with the Preschool, being succeeded by Gill Dedhar as leader of the well-trained and dedicated team.
