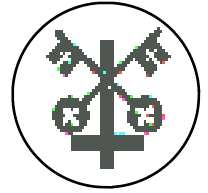

BOXTED PARISH COUNCIL SEEKS A NEW CLERK

The Clerk is a paid employee of the Council and National NALC Terms apply for remuneration and expenses. The Parish Clerk is a Responsible Financial Officer (RFO) and Proper Officer of the Council; he/she deals with the business of the Council, including correspondence, financial book-keeping and management of records, agenda items and takes minutes of all Council meetings.

The Clerk attends all meetings of the Parish Council. The post requires an average of 13 hours per week, however, the work load will vary. The Council meets on the 2nd Wednesday of the month commencing at 1900 10 times per annum. There is no Parish Office, and the Clerk works from home, for which the statutory allowance is paid.

The successful applicant will be computer literate, possess excellent inter-personal skills, must be adaptable and able to interact effectively with councillors, residents and officers of other organisations.

Ideally applicants will have a sound local government background and hold the Certificate in Local Council Administration or be prepared to undertake this qualification.
