BOXTED

Items from the 9 March meeting

Boxted St Peter's CEVC School

The proposals to increase pupil numbers up to 210 by September 2015 at Boxted CE (VC) school were discussed in some detail. Mr Cowley, the Chairman of the school's Board of Governors attended the meeting and put the case for the school who are in favour of the increase as it will not only mean more funding for them but it will also provide three new classrooms which free up the library and ICT suites, and will also mean that children no longer have to be taught in mixed year or mixed key stage groups. After much debate the Council agreed that whilst they were fully supportive of the School Governors and the staff in their efforts to maintain and improve standards at the school, they could not support an increase in pupil numbers because of the increased traffic and problematic parking issues that would be caused by the proposed additional 70 pupils.

Allotments

The Council currently have a list of approximately 20 people who have expressed an interest in taking up an allotment but we are still desperately seeking some suitable land. We would need a minimum of 1 acre and a maximum of 2 acres to accommodate the people on our current waiting list. Do you have any land that you would be prepared to lease to be used as allotments? Alternatively is there anyone who has a large garden who would be happy to see part of it used as an allotment for one or two people? Council Tax Bills/Annual Budgets

The Council are pleased to confirm that despite a cut of 50% to the Revenue Support Grant usually provided annually by Colchester Borough Council, the Parish Council have been able to use some of its reserves to keep the Parish element of the Council tax bill at the same level as last year, with no increases.

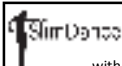
