BOXTED HISTORY GROUP

Pip Wright showed the October meeting how it was possible to enjoy a Suffolk bus journey *and* reach your destination in time to see the sights. Bus routes take in small villages often missed in car journeys; bus passengers are readily conversational and one's knowledge of Suffolk grows accordingly. But do acquire and keep with you the very latest bus timetable.

Richard Carr, the keeper of the Paxman Archives, replaced Andrew Philips as the speaker in November and gave an interesting and detailed account of the firm founded by James Paxman in the late 19th century. The firm's steam engines and associated machinery helped to foster the rapid development of electric power; in later years its diesel engines were installed in ships and railway locomotives throughout the world.
