LANGHAM HERITAGE INFORMATION BOARDS

Using funds allocated to Langham by Colchester Borough Council to mark the Queen's Diamond Jubilee, the Parish Council commissioned two display boards showing a large map of Langham and images (many of them "then & now") of significant places around the village. The boards are the product of months of research and preparation by the Parish Council's Heritage Committee, led by Tony Ellis, in conjunction with Atlas UK, based at Fordham. One board is at the entrance to Langham Community Centre, the other at the USAAF monument in Park Lane. The Community Centre board was unveiled by Borough Councillor Mark Cable on 6 July at a ceremony attended by Langham residents, members of the Parish Council and representatives of Atlas UK. The boards serve to

give useful and interesting information for residents and visitors alike (and directions to strangers) and even now provide a few surprises for those who thought they knew Langham inside out!

ST MARY'S CHURCH: **MEMORIAL TO WILFRID TOLHURST**

The Dedham Vale Society's (DVS) project of erecting a flagpole at St Mary's Church in memory of the late Wilf Tolhurst of Langham Hall, a benefactor to the church and at the time of his death chairman of the DVS, has been fraught with problems since its inception in 2009. The final and insuperable obstacle has been the insistence the of Diocese lightning that а conductor should be installed and the stipulation of the church's insurers this that installation should give protection not just to the flagpole, but to the whole church. This full protection would raise the cost beyond the means of the DVS and so, with great regret, the project has been abandoned.

The DVS has received many generous donations, as well as a grant, and is now considering other appropriate schemes in memory of its late chairman.
